Hevik Technical Shirt (HUW01) and Pants (HUW02)

Too often we take the easy option and wear cotton T-shirts, but technical kit really does make a big difference, both in summer and winter. It can mean the difference between a comfortable ride in the rain, and being convinced your textile kit is no longer waterproof.

These Hevik garments have become my favourite underwear for every kind of riding, all year round. The fit and feel is silky smooth, and they expand effortlessly to hug your body profile perfectly.

They're made from a combination of Polyamide, carbon fibre, Spandex and a material called **DRYARN**, which is anti-bacterial. The 2% carbon fibre construction makes the clothing anti-static. The material is breathable, and wicks your sweat away, plus it also insulates so you can maintain warmth when it's cold.

The sizes are available from small to XXL, but be prepared to go for a larger size than you'd first imagine – I wear large and I'm a 38/40in chest.
